MAXIMUM OF TWO CHAMPIONSHIPS PER HORSE over TWO CONSECUTIVE LEVELS AND THREE HORSES PER RIDER

Qualification Rules:

Horses entered must have competed at least once in the previous 12 months at an Allora dressage competition at the level entered. Entering but not actually competing is not sufficient. **Horses** may be substituted for other qualified ones in some exceptions ie horse sold and replaced. Please contact the event organiser to confirm acceptance of substitution.

Riders: must be a financial members of the Allora Show Society. In the case of **Preparatory**, the horse will not be eligible if it has won at a higher level in the competition period. (eg, if it has been awarded a 1st place at any Preliminary level test it cannot compete at the Preparatory level at these Championships). If in doubt, please contact Marie 0408 304 628

Juniors: 17 years of age and under unless otherwise stated. **Seniors:** 18-49 years of age. **Masters :** 50 years of age and over. **Open:** All age groups

Copies of the Tests: Copies are available at www.qld.equestrian.org.au (Note that we are no longer using the Allora Show Society Tests).

Dress Formal: Jacket, sleeved shirt, suitable boots and helmet required. Saddlery as per EFA and PCAQ rules. Horses should be plaited and presented correctly. There will be "Best Presented" awards for each age group.

CHAMPIONSHIP RUGS: Any HORSE winning TWO championships will only be awarded the trophy rug of the higher level and the reserve champion of the lower level will receive that one. A RIDER may be awarded two rugs as long as it is on different horses.

The Tests will be the EA Tests. Prep level rides Prep B, Prep C & Prep D. Prelim rides 1A, 1B, 1C. Novice rides 2A, 2B, 2C. Elementary rides 3A, 3B, 3C. Medium rides 4A, 4B, 4C. Advanced rides 5A, 5B, 5C.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Friday 30th October. Correct entry fee must accompany nomination form or be direct debited. (payment on the day of the competition will not be accepted for this Championship) Draw will be emailed. The draw will be displayed at the venue.
